

Custom Fit Budget Review

What is it? Why is the State involved?

The Custom Fit program provides Utah companies with flexible, customized training for their employees that is tailored to meet the specific needs of the employer. The program provides training for large and small companies across all industries, including, but not limited to, manufacturing, mining, construction, service, processing, technology, and healthcare. The mission of the program is to support economic and workforce development and facilitate the creation of new jobs in the state.

Organization

The Custom Fit program consists of training partnerships between Utah companies and the Utah College of Applied Technology, Utah State University – Eastern, Snow College, and Salt Lake Community College.

Funding

- Each participating company contributes a minimum of 50 percent of the direct training costs. Exceptions can be made on a case-by-case basis, but, currently, on average, employers provide more than 50 percent of the direct training costs.
- In FY 2016, in total the company contribution was 76 percent of the appropriation.
