Protects cohabitants from abuse or domestic violence

Ends when probation ends

OPTIONS



- TAKE NO ACTION

 - OPEN BILL FILE WITH POINT PERSON FROM THE COMMITTEE
 - ASSIGN A COMMITTEE MEMBER TO WORK WITH AN INFORMAL WORKING GROUP TO STUDY AND PROPOSE LEGISLATION, IF ANY
