- Our current system for poll watchers has remained basically unchanged for over 20 years, however elections have changed significantly.
- In 1997:
  - Voting by mail required an application to be an "absent elector"
  - There was no early voting
  - Voting in person used a punch card or pen and paper
  - No vote centers

 Poll watchers are appointed by registered political parties and candidates, and by any person interested in a ballot proposition appearing on the ballot.

 Poll watchers shall have an affidavit from the appointing party or individual

- Code currently allows for 3 types of poll watchers.
  - o One poll watchers that observe voting,
  - o One poll watchers that observe counting, and
  - One poll watchers that observe the securing of ballot packages (see 20A-3-201).

#### Voting Poll Watcher

- May watch and observe the voting process
- Make written memorandum
- May not interfere in any way with the process, except to challenge a voter
  - A person who lives in a voting precinct may challenge a voter's right to vote, if both the voter and the person making the challenge are present when the challenge is made

- Voting Poll Watcher Issues
  - Vote by mail
    - Cannot watch and observe the voting process
    - Cannot challenge a voter when they vote
  - Vote centers
    - Since any voter can vote at any vote center difficult for challenger to live in same precinct as a voter

#### Counting Poll Watcher

- Shall remain in the counting room until the close of polls
- May not divulge the progress of the count until the count is complete



- Counting takes place long after the polls are closed
- What should the policies and procedures look like for a vote by mail counting watcher?

#### Inspecting Poll Watcher

- Inspect the condition and observe the securing of ballot packages
- Inspect the condition of packages containing ballots upon their arrival to the clerk
- Observe the placement of these packages in a safe and secure place

- Inspecting Poll Watcher Issues
  - Most ballots now arrive in the mail
