




Overall freshmen headcount increased by 5.9%.





### 2016 Strongest Academic Class Ever












Our international students' skills are in demand with local and national employers who are facing a shortage of qualified technology talent. I can't imagine what our University would be like without these students. They are an important part of our community.






Bachelors degree recipients, 4 quarters after graduation [2013-14 & 2014-15 years]
