Context

- In 2014 DWS was requested, by Utah Senate President Niederhauser, to analyze wage ratios, adjusted for cost-of-living differences, across a group of selected occupations (including education related occupations)
 - DWS was assigned task due to specialization in labor economics
- Expanded on original request by extending analysis to:
 - Intrastate wage analysis, controlling for education level
 - Teacher migrating to other occupations
 - Inter-county salary driven mobility
 - Teachers commuting to adjacent foreign counties
 - Interstate education occupation mobility
 - Teachers migrating to other states

Macro


Comparison of average wages of teachers across similar western state metropolitans

Micro Comparison

Average starting wage data derived from OES are leveraged to compare occupations which require the exact same level of education (bachelor's degree). This elucidates on the possible economic incentive for future teachers to be dissuaded from acquiring a bachelor's degree in an education field; and for current teachers to re-enter college to gain a bachelor's degree in a field with higher average wages

Micro Comparison Cont.

2016 salary schedules are compared for adjacent counties: Uinta, WY; Elko, NV; and Clark, NV. This is to explore the possibility of teachers commuting to adjacent counties for employment, whilst residing in the state of Utah.



Macro Comparison

Average wages (2016 OES) are compared across similar western metropolitan centers. This ratio was adjusted for costof-living differentials (CCER 2016).

Summary

- Employing two methods to calculate wage differentials for education professions
 - Micro
 - Very strong evidence to suggest that average wages for the family of occupations which comprise the education occupation are lower than the "average" of all occupations
 - Very strong evidence to suggest that teachers residing near specific adjacent counties have tremendous economic incentive to reside in Utah and be employed across state lines
 - Macro
 - Compared to similar western metropolitan centers, with the exception of Albuquerque (three occupations) and secondary school teachers in Phoenix, Salt Lake City, as proxy for the state, has competitive pay
