

Treatment Population


AP&P Total Population*

Risk





DORA Client Outcomes: Improvements from Admission to Discharge

Alcohol Abstinence	77.9%	89.1%
Drug Abstinence	28.8%	61.3%
Employment/Education	38.1%	50.1%
Stable Housing	92.8%	93.4%
Criminal Justice Involvement	40.0%	13.9%
Use of Recovery Supports	25.6%	29.3%


Weber Human Services CPC Domain Effectiveness
