
SUMMARY

This issue brief provides information on student headcount at Utah System of Technical Colleges for high school (secondary) and adult students.


DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

The following figures provide the student headcount from FY 2014 to FY 2017 for four distinct categories of students: certificate-seeking, continuing occupational education, other post-secondary, and secondary students. The first figure illustrates the total student headcount for each category across all the applied technology colleges. The remaining figures provide the student headcount for each student category by college. System-wide student headcount has fluctuated over time. Recently, student headcount had been steadily growing, but following significant policy modifications saw a decline of almost 1,000 students in 2017. In FY 2016 USTC had a total of 35,819 students while in FY 2017 student headcount fell to 34,778. This growth was among all student categories except for other post-secondary students.


Utah System of Technical Colleges, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2017




Bridgerland Technical College, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2017




Davis Technical College, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2017




Dixie Technical College, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2017




Mountainland Technical College, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2017




Ogden-Weber Technical College, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2017
