ISSUE BRIEF

The nonlapsing intent language requested by the Department of Technology Services for the 2018 General Session is shown below.

NONLAPSING INTENT LANGUAGE

Chief Information Officer: \$676,000

Under the terms of Utah Code Annotated Section 63J-1-603, the Legislature intends that appropriations provided for Chief Information Officer shall not lapse at the close of FY 2018. Expenditures of these funds are limited to: 1) Costs associated with DTS rate study and/or optimization initiatives, 2) To implement the provisions of Postal Facilities and Government Services (Senate Bill 65, 2017 General Session) SB0003, 3) Single Sign On Initiative, and 4) Data coordination system: \$676,000

Integrated Technology Division: \$1,634,000

Under the terms of Utah Code Annotated Section 63J-1-603, the Legislature intends that appropriations provided for Integrated Technology Division in Item 31, Chapter 4, Laws of Utah 2017, shall not lapse at the close of FY 2018. Expenditures of these funds are limited to 1) Geographic Reference Center projects, Global Positioning System Reference Network upgrades and maintenance, ~~S~~urvey ~~M~~onument ~~R~~estoration grant obligations to local government, and 2) Federal Funds award for Lidar Acquisition Projects: \$1,634,000.
