## **Programs-**

### **Restorative Discipline Practices**

Restorative Discipline Practices are a proactive approach to transforming school climate and student behavior through reaffirming, rebuilding and repairing relationships with peers and adults when conflicts arise and implementing consequences that foster belonging, connectedness and repairing harm, as opposed to exclusionary consequences, which prevent students from engaging in first time face-to-face instruction.

Restorative Practices courses offered through Stand4Kind are researched-based and designed to enhance the skills and strategies of classroom teachers in understanding the importance of relationships, proactive classroom management strategies, positive student support and problem solving for inappropriate student behaviors.

### **Mindfulness in Education, Youth and Parenting**

Mindful Training building emotional intelligence enhances social and emotional learning and resilience's. Learn how to integrate mindfulness into your work with youth using our research-backed K-12 Mindful Curriculum. Our curriculum – used by educators, mental health professionals, social workers, and parents across the U.S. – is adaptable for classrooms, after-school programs, clinical settings, and home. It uses developmentally appropriate language for explaining key mindfulness concepts and practices to youth, educators and parents.

**Project Firefly: Lighting the path for Life**

Prevention:

Protective factors we can categorize them into five domains youth, family, peer, community and society. Protective factors can be defined as "a characteristic at the biological, psychological, family or community (including peers and culture) level that is associated with a lower likelihood of problem outcomes or that reduces the negative impact of a risk factor on problem outcomes." -

**Stand4Kind App & Resource Line**

- Mobile app with resources that teach students how to respond to and prevent bullying, and promote
- positive behavior.
- To use the Resource Line, the student answers a series of questions and is provided with instant access to videos, tips, and other training materials customized to the type of bullying they face.
- Designed to teach students positive ways to prevent bullying, cyberbullying, drug, crisis, self-harm harassment, based on gender, orientation, religion, race and more.
- Can also be used to submit anonymous bullying tips to the school and open 2-way anonymous communication between students and school staff. (Works with school's current tip lines)
- Students can submit Acts of Kindness to participate in monthly Stand4Kind giveaways.
- Each registered student gets a unique in-app QR code that school officials can track data

## Anti-Bullying Coalition Summary

- Youth suicide continues to plague our communities
  - 1 in 4 students say they are currently victims of bullying
  - The youth suicide rate in Utah is 2.5 times higher than the national average (Utah: 11.1 suicides per 100,000 population)
  - In 2017, 45 youths (ages 10-17) committed suicide with “bullying and drug use” cited as the most common reasons.
  - The 2017 number is up from 33 in 2016 – that’s a 140% increase.
  - As stated previously, the Anti-Bullying Coalition knows of 48 lives that have been saved due to our interventions.
