The funding would be immediately used toward the \$3.5 million debt service incurred on March 1, 2018, for the acquisition of an 85-bed nursing home which requires no remodeling and includes all furniture, fixtures and equipment. The reduction in debt service ensures the program's sustainability by offsetting operating costs.

- 3. Performance Measures:**

The new facility has five times the bed capacity of The INN Between's current facility, ensuring that no one will die in the streets while bridging the medical bed gap in the new resource center model. Performance will be measured by occupancy rates as well as the reduction in the number of deaths on the streets and the elimination of unnecessary 911 calls. The INN Between expects to serve 400 terminally ill or medically frail homeless adults annually.
