

FY19 - INDEPENDENT LIVING/ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY REQUEST

The Independent Living (IL)/Assistive Technology (AT) Program is requesting \$800,000 On-Going to assist individuals with disabilities to live more independently in their homes and communities.

All of the requested \$800,000 will be used to purchase assistive technology devices for consumers. Some examples include: ramps, wheelchairs, walkers, shower chairs, stair glides, track ceiling lifts, scooters, lift chairs, seating and mobility equipment, low vision aides and adaptive hearing devices.

*There is currently a waiting list of **76 individuals** with disabilities needing **89 devices** at a cost of \$315,295.

*FY 2018 AT services throughout Utah:

- **239 devices** have been provided to **210 people** with disabilities at a cost of \$814,574, to assist them in living more independently within their own home and community.

FY 2017 AT services throughout Utah:

- **303 devices** have been provided to **268 people** with disabilities at a cost of \$842,000, to assist them in living more independently within their own home and community.

FY 2016 AT services throughout Utah:

- **229 devices** have been provided to **195 people** with disabilities to assist them in living more independently within their own home and community.

FY 2015 AT services throughout Utah:

- **253 devices** were provided to **213 people** with disabilities to assist them in living more independently within their own home and community.

Success will be measured by:

1. Total number of consumers provided services will MEET or exceed the previous year (210)
2. Total number of assistive technology devices will MEET or exceed the previous year (239)
