29 (1) (a) "News media" means a printed, photographic, electromagnetic, or electronic
30 means {~~of disseminating~~} **of communication that is used to disseminate** news to the general public.

31 (b) "News media" includes a newspaper, magazine, press association, news agency,

32 wire service, radio station, television station, {~~and~~} **or** television network **, that is used to disseminate news to the general public.**
