- 1 Page 13, Lines 380 through 390
- 380 (5) (a) The division shall review the database to identify { and investigate } any prescriber
- 381 who has a pattern of prescribing opioids not in accordance with the recommendations of:
- 382 (i) the CDC Guideline for Prescribing Opioids for Chronic Pain, published by the
- 383 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention;
- 384 (ii) the Utah Clinical Guidelines on Prescribing Opioids for Treatment of Pain,
- 385 published by the Utah Department of Health; or
- 386 (iii) other publications describing best practices related to prescribing opioids as
- 387 identified by division rule in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative
- 388 Rulemaking Act, and in consultation with the Physicians Licensing Board.
- 389 (b) The division shall { provide training or other } offer education to a prescriber identified
- 390 under this Subsection (5) regarding best practices in the prescribing of opioids.
- (c) A decision by a prescriber to accept or not accept the education offered by the division under this Subsection (5) is voluntary.
- (d) The division may not use an identification the division has made under this Subsection (5) or the decision by a prescriber to accept or not accept education offered by the division under this Subsection (5) in a licensing investigation or action by the division.
- (e) Any record created by the division as a result of this Subsection (5) is a protected record under Section 63G-2-305.
