1 Page 4, Lines 110 through 114

110 (b) (i) { ~~This section does not prohibit an~~ } An owner or lessor of private housing  
111 accommodations { ~~from charging a person, including [a person]~~ { ~~an individual~~ } { ~~with a disability, a~~ }  
112 { ~~reasonable deposit as security for any damage or wear and tear that might be caused by a~~ }  
113 { ~~service animal~~ } { ~~or assistance animal~~ } { ~~if the owner or lessor would charge a similar deposit to~~ }  
114 ~~other persons for potential wear and tear.~~ } may charge a person, including an individual with a  
disability who is accompanied by a service animal or an assistance animal, the same security deposit for wear  
and tear that the owner or lessor charges to other persons who are not accompanied by a service animal or  
an assistance animal.  
(ii) An owner or lessor of private housing may not charge an extra fee or deposit for a service or assistant  
animal.
