Hill Air Force Base F-35 Force Build-up Plan

- Hill Air Force Base First Operational F-35 Base in the Air Force
- 40 Aircraft on Station Today
- ► 57 Aircraft Planned by End of CY 2018
- Full Compliment of 78 Aircraft Planned by End of CY 2019
- Build-up Accompanied by Additional Depot Work and Personnel Growth in the Operational Wings and the Depot
- Air Force Leadership Very Pleased with Hill Progress to Date



Dugway Proving Ground Remote Location Challenges

- Dugway 45 Miles from Nearest Town with Support Services
- Army Designation of "Remote and Isolated" Does Little to Address Dugway Needs
- UDA Meetings with Senior Army Officials Making Some Progress
 - Resident Contractor Use of Commissary Nearing Resolution
- Discussed Putting More Teeth in "Remote and Isolated" Designation with Assistant Secretary of the Army in June 2018
- Will Follow Up as Needed Until Dugway Issues Resolved





- Air Force Analysis of Basing Options for F-35 HPSI Office Ongoing
 - ▶ 400 Person Organization
- Hill Air Force Base One of Six Option Locations
- UDA Believes Hill is Logical Choice due to Extensive Fighter Aircraft Product Support Experience & Colocation with Other F-35 Activities
 - Not All Stakeholders Agree
- UDA Working Hard to Promote Hill Advantages to Air Force Leadership
- Secretary of the AF Decision Due This Summer



Hill Air Force Base Software Facility Update

- Hill AFB Software Facility Construction a Joint Utah-Air Force Project
- Basic Facility Construction on Track for Summer Completion
- Air Force Security Certification and Installation of Furnishings and Lab Equipment Will Begin Once Construction is Complete
- Initial Operating Capability Planned for End of Q1 2019
- Hill Continues to Hire Additional 200 Software Personnel Each Year

Hill Air Force Base Ground Based Strategic Deterrent Program Growth

- GBSD is Air Force Replacement Program for Minuteman III ICBM
 - Managed at Hill Air Force Base
- Air Force's Largest Ongoing Procurement Program (\$65B)
- Program Office Growth by Over 250 Personnel in Next Five Years
 - Will be Accompanied by Growth in Support Contractors as Well
- FY 2020 Military Construction Project Will Provide Program Office Space
 - May be Accompanied by Additional Enhanced Use Lease Office Space for Support Contractors
