Background

- Initial discussions began in 2012
- Informal group started meeting in 2013
- Utah Veterans Owned Business Partnership formally started in 2014
- Survey hosted on UDVMA website (400+ responded)
- Business resources listed on UDVMA website
 - www.veterans.utah.gov/business
 - Education & Training, Access to Business Loans, Mentorship, Procurement, etc.,
- Annual Veteran Owned Business Summit (started in 2015)
- Veterans Business Resource Center began 2017
 - Hosted at Miller Business Resource Center, Salt Lake Community College

















Veteran-Owned Businesses in Utah

- Thousands of veteran-owned businesses in Utah
 - National estimate is about 9% all businesses are VOB
 - Utah estimate was 7.2% in 2011
- Retail, manufacturing, construction, recreational and consulting businesses
- Both veteran-owned and spouse-owned businesses
- 30 attendees at Boots to Business; 10-25 at Re-Boot; 5 at Advanced Training
- VOBs in Utah are run by both currently serving military and previously served veterans



Utah Veterans Business Resource Center

- Provides services to veterans across the state
- Helps define business objective (supplemental or primary)
- Hosts quarterly veterans business breakfasts along the Wasatch Front
- One-on-one mentoring (remote or in-person)
- Boots-to-Business/Re-Boot 2-day program
- Customized/advanced business training for mature businesses (12+ months)
- Micro-grant capability
- Connects veterans to additional partner programs
