

**Payment Processing** 



- Most banks follow federal rules and cannot accept marijuana money
- States are exempt from federal reporting guidelines and <u>can</u> collect revenue from marijuana taxes and fees









- Many requests for industrial hemp and marijuana edibles
- "Medicinal dose form" language would exclude edibles
- Violates Wholesome Food Act (UCA 4-5-103)
   as defined by Food Additives (21 US Code 348)











- Cannot be used in animal feed: Utah
   Administrative Code R68-2-12(b), would
   render animal feed "adulterated" if used
- See also Code of Federal Regulations, Title 21,
   Parts 225 and 226, Sections 225.1 225.115
   and 226.1 226.115











- HB 197: UDAF shall "establish '<u>a</u>' state dispensary" by July 1, 2019
- Demand may exceed the capacity at a single dispensary
- UDAF does not currently have the infrastructure to provide this service
- Transport and location security protocols require significant consideration
