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## REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

*#1 - The timelines set for testing all sexual assault kits submitted to the Utah Bureau of Forensic Services and the goals established in Section 76-5-603*

- ✓ First Priority – within 30 days from the date of submission
- ✓ Second Priority – within 60 days from the date of submission
- ✓ Third Priority – within 180 days from the date of submission

*#2 - The status of meeting those goals*

- ✓ A total of 373 Sexual Assault cases were completed July 2017-June 2018
- ✓ 11% of Sexual Assault cases were completed within the established timeline goals
- ✓ 9 Positions Hired (Received funding for 9 of 17 positions requested in fiscal note of HB200)
  - 6 Trained
  - 3 Training (all training will be completed by December 2018)
  - funding for 8 positions still needed
- ✓ Sexual Assault Tracking System went live April 2018
- ✓ Basic training video for patrol officers developed and implemented as mandated in statute
- ✓ Advanced sexual assault training curriculum for investigators developed and scheduled to be taught this fall



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*#3 - The number of sexual assault kits that are sent to the Utah Bureau of Forensic Services for testing:*

- 1,196 Sexual Assault Kits Submitted to the laboratory July 2017-June 2018

*#4 - The number of restricted kits held by law enforcement:*

- 5 Sexual Assault Kits are currently classified as *Restricted*

*#5 - The number of sexual assault kits that are not processed in accordance with the timelines established in this part*

- 1,880 cases currently backlogged
