What are Vaccines?

Vaccines are substances that teach your immune system what an invasive microbe looks like. This allows your body to protect itself from specific diseases. It is a natural process that uses your body's own natural defense system to keep you safe from serious illnesses.

This process is more natural than medicines, treatments, or vitamin supplements. It makes use of your body's strengths and protects you from diseases that could do serious harm.



We added a "back button" to allow the user to go to the previous slide. This was also recommended by many users who have taken the module.

User input told us they wanted more information about vaccine safety. Many of the users were concerned about autism and said they wanted more information. We have provided links to studies where they can go to get more information.

Vaccines Are Safe

Vaccines are a safe and effective way to protect your health. Due to a fraudulent study written by a discredited doctor, some people mistakenly believe that vaccines can cause autism.
