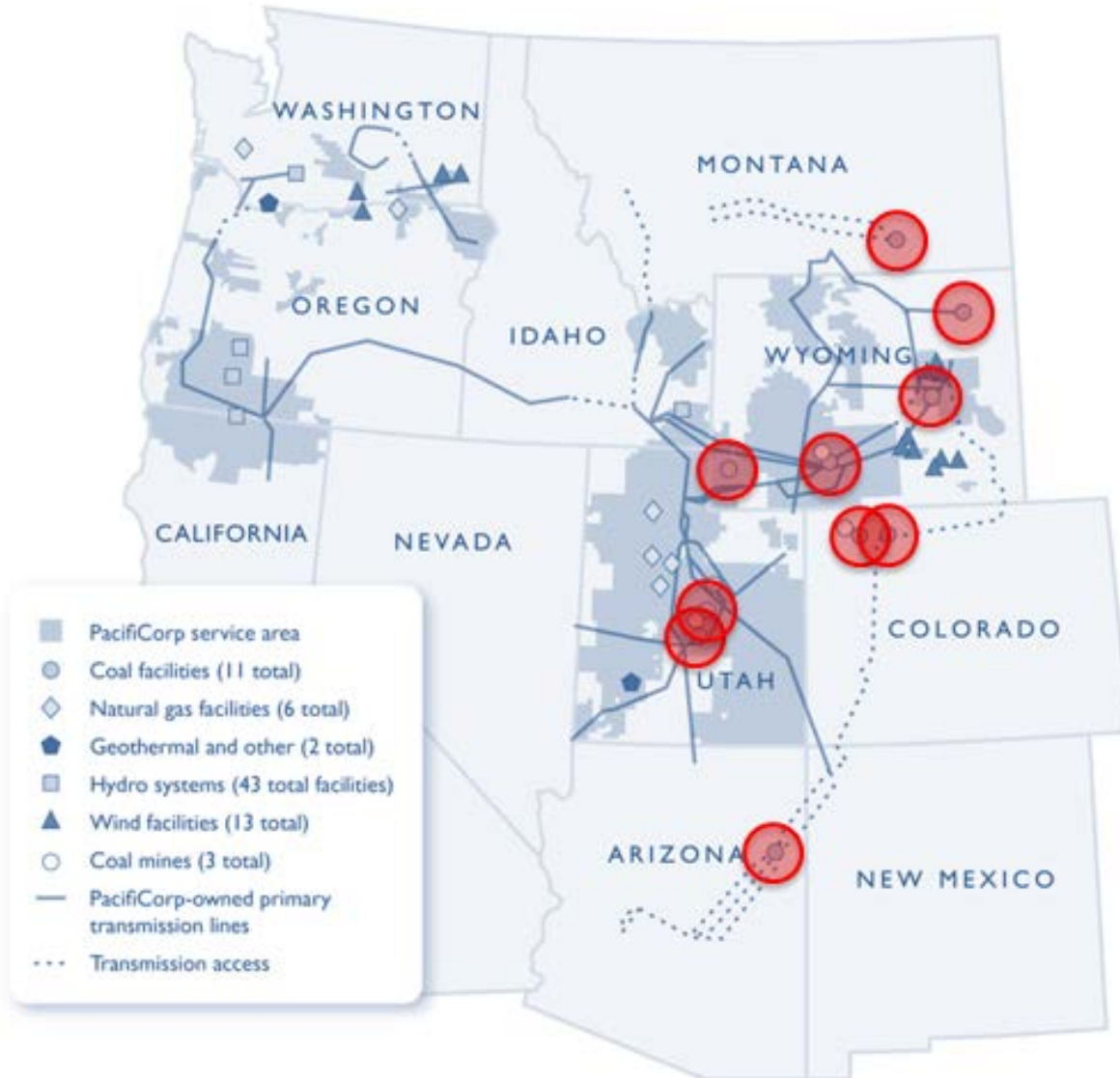
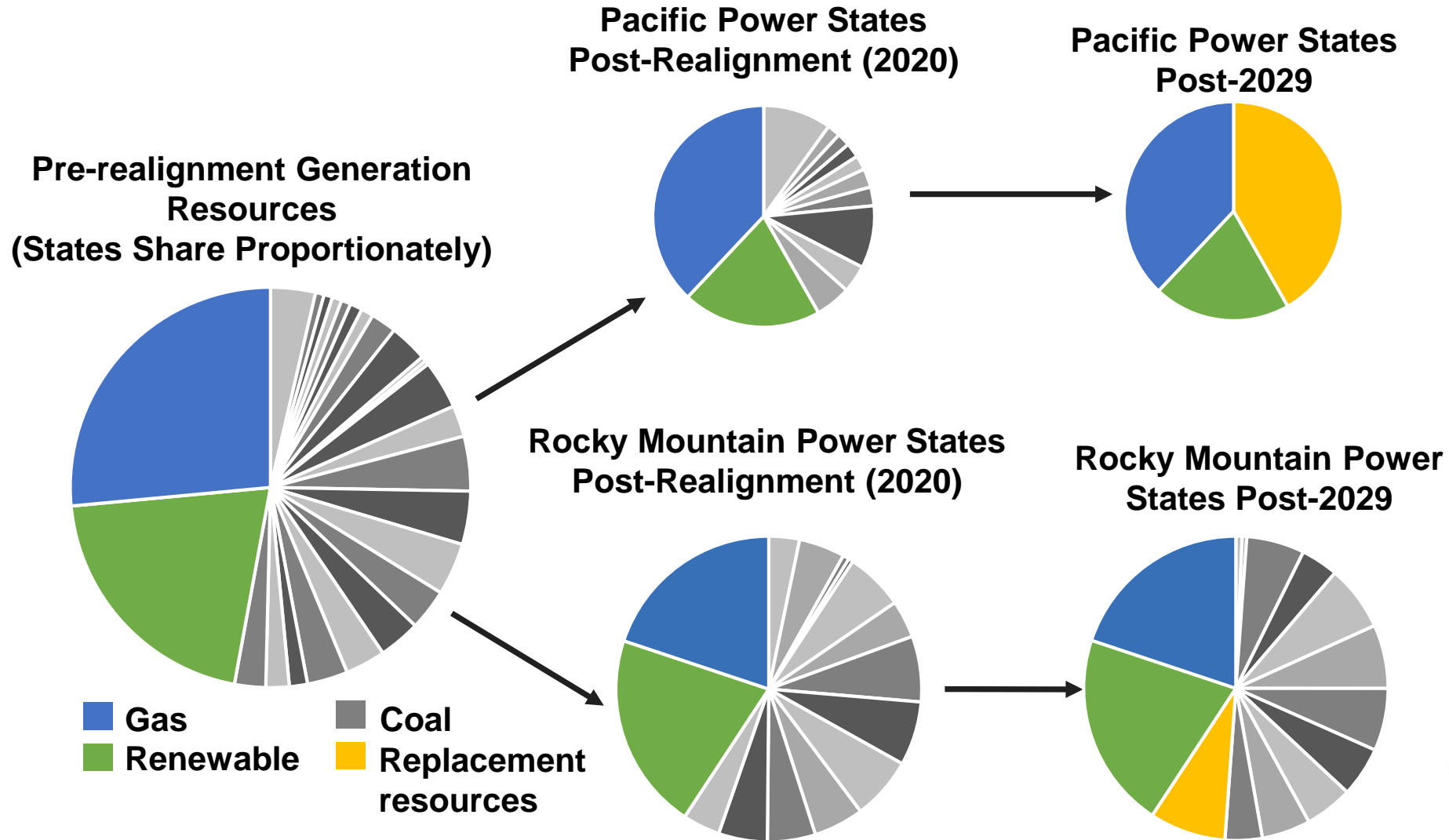

Coal Plant Realignment



What the proposal accomplishes

- Maintains the benefits of the integrated system while achieving greater state autonomy.
- Provides a pathway for state energy policies to diverge, while ensuring that the costs and benefits of all state policy decisions remain with the responsible state to the degree possible.
- Leverages the opportunity to align states that are depreciating coal assets on a faster schedule with coal units that are anticipated to be retired in the near term.

Rocky Mountain Power Key Principles

- Allow for more state autonomy in new resource portfolio selection
- Follow cost-causation principles
- Minimize rate impacts at implementation
- Maintain/optimize system-wide benefits and joint dispatch
- Enable compliance with state initiatives and laws
- Provide longer-term, more durable solution
