

## Irrigation Efficiencies

“The appropriator of water does not acquire title to the corpus of the water but acquires only the right to use the quantity reasonably necessary to mature the crops and for other beneficial purposes. Regardless of the amount of water originally appropriated or historically used, the amount reasonably necessary is the limitation of the quantity appropriated.”

Expanded Instream Flow Use



### 73-3-30. Change application for an instream flow

- Instream flow rights can be obtained by the Utah Division of Wildlife and the Division of Parks and Recreation by obtaining an approval on a change application filed for instream flow on a perfected right they have obtained.
- A non-profit fishing group may file a fixed-time change application for instream flow for three specific native trout species.
