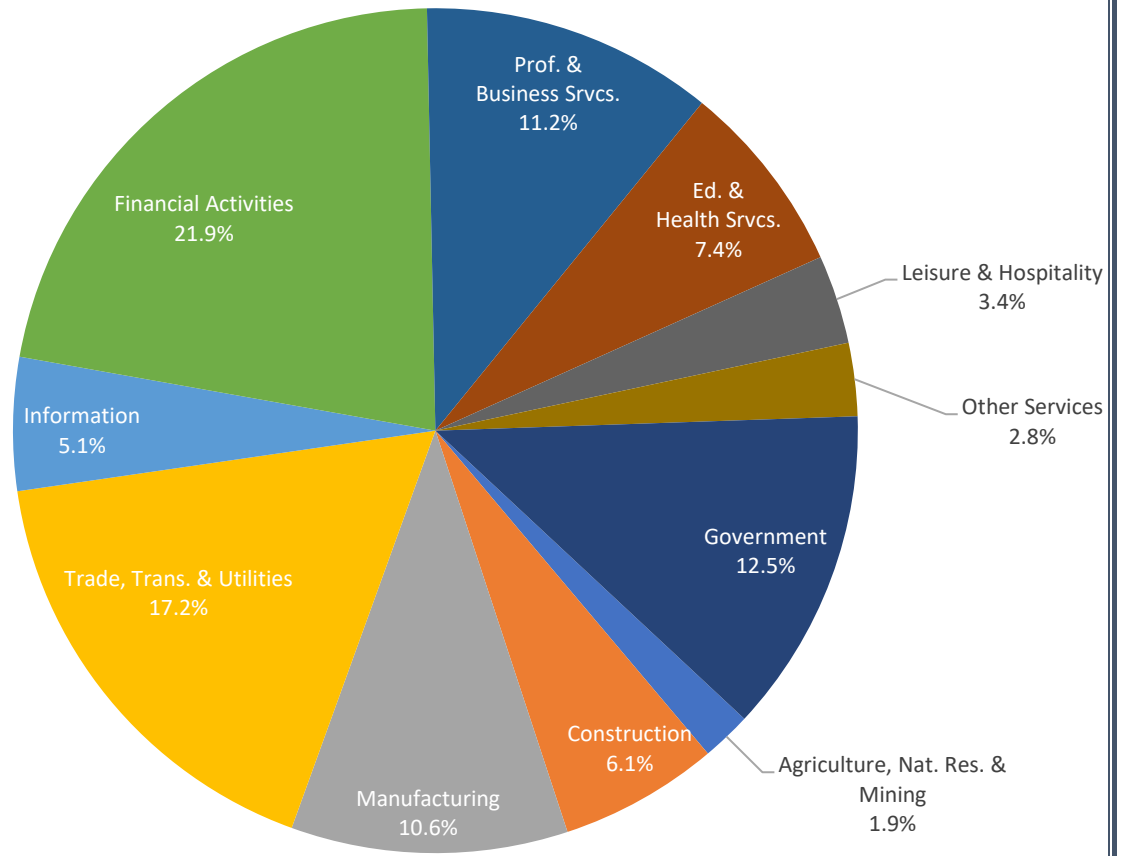
### Hospitality & Leisure

Visitor spending:	\$9.15 billion
Contribution to GDP:	\$5.10 billion
State/local tax revenue	\$1.34 billion
Hospitality/Leisure jobs:	143,036

### Agriculture, Natural Resources, & Mining

Contribution to GDP:	\$2.85 billion
Cattle ranching families:	6,000
Mining jobs:	8,618
