SUMMARY

Each year, the Subcommittee is asked to give approval for the expansion of institutions’ motor pools. For FY 2020, five of the UTECH institutions are requesting authorization to expand their fleets. The total increase is 11 vehicles, including 5 new vehicles and 6 replacements, as shown on the following table.
