History

Utah Forensic System

500% growth in
30 years

- 1988 The Utah State Hospital operated a 30 Bed Forensic Unit
- 1993 Hospital increased to 60 Bed Unit
- 2000 100 Bed Forensic Building opened
- 2015 Outreach Program (ORP) begins
- FY18 22 bed Jail Based Program funded
- FY19 12 beds added at USH

Forensic Program Referrals



Projected Referrals

USH is projecting 208 referrals in FY 2019. However, DHS received 110 referrals in the first six months of FY 2019.

Referrals could reach 220 by the end of the year if the rate continues.




Wait List

Settlement Agreement Wait Time Deadlines


- 60 Days (March 31, 2018)

Internal Efficiencies

Discharged long-term patients, decreasing length of stay of active patients by 222 days.

Decreased median discharged length of stay for all programs.





Total Served at Utah State Hospital

Internal efficiencies have increased the number of patients treated in the inpatient setting.

FY 19 is estimated based on data from first 6 months of the year.

Current Status

- Average wait time for inpatient admission is down from 168 days to 11 days, a **93% reduction** in one year (December 2018)
- Longest current wait time is 21 days
- Average number of patients waiting for inpatient admission is 5 (December 2018)
- Percent of patients restored to competency (FY 2019, July - December)
 - *Outreach: 61% (includes individuals in community on 'own recognizance')*
 - *Jail-Based: 72%*
 - *Inpatient: 71%*
