- 104 designee; and
- 105 {-(i)} (i) as appointed by the chair, one or more individuals with expertise in mental stress or
- 106 occupational medicine to serve as ex officio, nonvoting members of the workgroup.
- Page 5, Lines 127 through 132:
- (7) The workgroup shall present a final report on the items described in Subsection (6),
- 128 including any legislative recommendations, to the Business and Labor Interim Committee on or
- 129 before September 30, { 2019 } 2020 .

- 131 63I-2-234. Repeal dates -- Title 34A.
