

#### SIX-YEAR GRADUATION RATE









#### FRESHMAN ACADEMIC PROFILE

## RESIDENTS WHO STAY IN UTAH AFTER GRADUATING


- Bachelor's degrees

  - ~ 45% stay in Utah








#### HIGH-DEMAND JOBS IN UTAH

Degrees awarded in the high-growth fields of computer science, engineering, health professions, social sciences and business\*








