## Other Motions for Consideration

1. Intent Language: I move the following intent language

Under section 63J-1-603 of the Utah Code, the Legislature intends that appropriations up to \$700,000 provided for the Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice in Item 28 of Chapter 8 Laws of Utah 2018 not lapse at the close of fiscal year 2019. The use of any unused funds is limited to contracts between Salt Lake County and other counties to house inmates or for housing Salt Lake County inmates in Oxbow.

The legislature intends that any payments from the Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice for housing prisoners from Salt Lake County in other counties be limited to the rate of \$26 per day, per prisoner.

The Legislature intends that the General Fund appropriation for Salt Lake County Jail Bed Funding discontinues at the close of Fiscal Year 2021.

The Legislature intends that the Corrections and Sheriffs Association report on Jail Contracting treatment during the 2019 interim to the Executive Offices and Criminal Justice Appropriations Subcommittee

The Legislature intends that Jail Reimbursement program funding is contingent on county jail submission of all standards, rules, regulations, or policies, as well as all non-privileged supporting documentation, that the govern the operations of the county jails, including the Utah Jail Standards. 'Supporting documentation' shall include all reports or other documentation that is based on any internal or external audit, inspection, or evaluation of the county jails that seeks to measure compliance with any of the foregoing standards, rules, regulations, or policies, including any audits or evaluations performed by the Utah Sheriff's Association.

- **2. Study Items:** I move to have the Legislature study the following during the 2019 interim:
  - a. The Indigent Defense Commission grant program to maximize efficiency ability to best represent qualified indigent defendants, including alternative options to structure the program.
  - b. Judicial Districts, including history, potential alternative options factoring efficiencies.
  - c. A complete copy of all standards, rules, regulations, or policies, as well as all nonprivileged supporting documentation, that the govern the operations of the county jails, including the Utah Jail Standards.
  - d. Pre-Sentence Investigation (PSI) Reports study options to minimize the required information and length of the report.
  - e. Highway Patrol/Aero Bureau study use of emerging technology including drone usage for law enforcement and search and rescue.
- **3. Aero Bureau:** I move to have the Aero Bureau report on progress toward certification and contract status with the federal government as it relates to search and rescue on federal public lands during the 2019 interim.
