Alcoholic Beverage Control - State Store Land Acquisition Fund

1. *Under section 63J-1-603 of the Utah Code, Legislature intends that up to \$5,000,000 of the General Fund provided for State Store Land acquisition not lapse at the close of Fiscal Year 2019. These funds will be used for the acquisition of land for state liquor stores.*

Heritage and Arts - Arts and Museums

2. *Under section 63J-1-603 of the Utah Code, Legislature intends that up to \$300,000 of the General Fund provided by Item 40, Chapter 15, Laws of Utah 2018 for the Department of Heritage and Arts - Division of Arts and Museums not lapse at the close of Fiscal Year 2019. These funds will be used as intended as the "Milk Money" appropriated during the 2018 General Session.*

Heritage and Arts - State Library

3. *Under section 63J-1-603 of the Utah Code, Legislature intends that up to \$240,000 of the General Fund provided by Item 47, Chapter 15, Laws of Utah 2018 for the Department of Heritage and Arts - Division of State Library not lapse at the close of Fiscal Year 2019. These funds will be used for building remodel and furnishings and library grants .*
