

HB 184 Civil Air Patrol License Plate

- The Civil Air Patrol works at a local, state, and federal level to supply aerial and ground support to emergency management officials, train and serve America's youth by providing access to programs and resources, and fulfill Air Force assigned missions. In 2018, the Civil Air Patrol worked tirelessly to save lives of those involved with Hurricane Florence and Michael, and they exposed over 400,000 cadets, teachers, and non-CAP students to aerospace and STEM careers.
- The Utah Wing of the Civil Air Patrol carries the mission of CAP into Utah. They work to train youth through their annual Flight Academy. This program, which teaches them the skills necessary to complete their first solo flight, sets up these youth for success in future flight training and careers.
- The Utah Wing of the Civil Air Patrol includes 326 adult members, 470 cadets, 79 aircrew personnel, and 365 emergency responders. These volunteer members represent an important part of Utah's community.
