


KEEP MY VOICE'S INITIATIVE/REMOVAL PROCESS OVERVIEW

Keep My Voice (KMV) began removing signatures the first week of April, roughly two weeks before initiative removals were due. We engaged in a six-week removal effort. Count My Vote began gathering signatures early November, roughly 25 weeks before initiative signatures were due.

SIGNATURES VS. DATE, EXPLAINED

Based on numbers reported by the Lieutenant Governor's website, the number of Direct Primary Election (DPE) signatures verified nearly tripled between March 10 and April 15, and increased roughly 330% by the time verification was complete.

The red dot represents the April 15 initiative signature deadline submission to county clerks



STATISTICS SPREADSHEET, EXPLANATION

Based on the 58.7% contact-to-removal ratio, had KMV contacted all DPE initiative signers, roughly 76,000 signatures would have been removed.

ISSUES WITH THE CURRENT INITIATIVE PROCESS

NOTIFICATION

No mechanism by which the signer is notified upon county processing. Signers have no idea if/when their signature
has been processed.

INFORMATION DELAY

- Initiative signers data requires GRAMA request with the Lieutenant Governor's office.
- This process can take up to 10 business days to respond.
- The amount of time to fill the request is up to the LG's office discretion and can cost.
- Removal efforts have weeks of delay just to contact initiative signers.

TIMELINE

- The current timeline is signatures are due April 15, removals are due May 14; Signature verification is expected of county clerks by May 15.
- · Changing the signature/removal dates to match on April 15, or any other selected date, creates three major issues:
- Fist, counties were verifying signatures until and past the May 15 deadline.
- · Second, Utah Supreme Court upheld the "right of removal" and rejected CMV's effort to be placed on the ballot.
- Third, political gamesmanship would abuse synced deadlines and voters will be limited in their educational process.

LIMITED INFORMATION

- Voters rarely read the initiative, despite affirming "by signing this petition, you are stating that you have read and understand the law proposed by this petition."
- · Gatherers carry multiple initiatives and do not adequately discuss what each does.
- There is a lack of layman's information online as to what each initiative does.
- By our own analysis, only eight articles were written between the Deseret News and Salt Lake Tribune about the
 Direct Primary Election initiative: Four about the launch or changes, two about the pros/cons (one of which was by
 Mike Leavitt), and two other.

REQUIRED INFORMATION

- A removal form requires the last 4 digits of their social security number and their drivers license or state ID number, in addition to all information required on the initiative; no clear justification has been made as to why by the LG's office.
- Requiring confidential personal information is a large deterrent for individuals wishing to remove their name from a
 petition.

UNCLEAR LAW (These have partially been addressed during the current legislative session)

- Keep My Voice received written confirmation from the Lieutenant Governor's office that the Social Security number
 and Drivers License or State ID number were not both required in order for a signer to remove their signature. When
 removal forms were verified by the LG's office more than 100 were rejected, most because they did not have both
 pieces of information, due to the LG's office's own mistake.
- Keep My Voice (KMV) worked with the LG's office to clarify when signatures were due. The LG's office confirmed signature removal forms were due on May 15. On May 14 the LG's office contacted Keep My Voice to inform us removals were due that day. KMV had 72 forms rejected by the LG's office because they were received on or after May 15.
