(D) person who requested the removal of the vehicle, vessel, or outboard motor; and 602

604 identification number and license number or other identification number issued by a state

605 agency; description, including the identification number, license number, or other identification number issued by a state agency, of the vehicle, vessel, or outboard motor;

606 (b) within two business days of performing the tow truck service under Subsection

Page 25, Lines 761 through 764:

761 (7) A towing entity may not require a tow truck operator who has received an

authorized towing certificate from the department to submit additional criminal background 762

763 check information for inclusion of the tow truck motor carrier on a rotation.

(8) If a tow truck motor carrier is dispatched as part of a towing rotation, the tow truck operator that responds may not respond to the location in a tow truck that is owned by a tow truck motor carrier that is different than the tow truck motor carrier that was dispatched.
