Amendment 1 H.B. 392

1. Page 3, Lines 59 through 73:

59 {(4) Before [December 1, 2017] November 1, 2019, the department shall report to the 60 Legislature's Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology Interim Committee and Health Reform 61 Task Force on:

62 (a) the result of the reimbursement requirement described in Subsection (3);

63 (b) existing and potential uses of telehealth and telemedicine services;

64 (c) issues of reimbursement to a provider offering telehealth and telemedicine services;

65 (d) potential rules or legislation related to:

66 (i) providers offering and insurers reimbursing for telehealth and telemedicine services;

67 and

68 (ii) increasing access to health care, increasing the efficiency of health care, and

69 decreasing the costs of health care; and

70 (e) the department's efforts to obtain a waiver from the federal requirement that

71 telemedicine communication be face-to-face communication.}

72 $\{\frac{(5)}{4}\}$ The Medicaid program shall reimburse for telepsychiatric consultations at a rate set

73 by the Medicaid program.
