



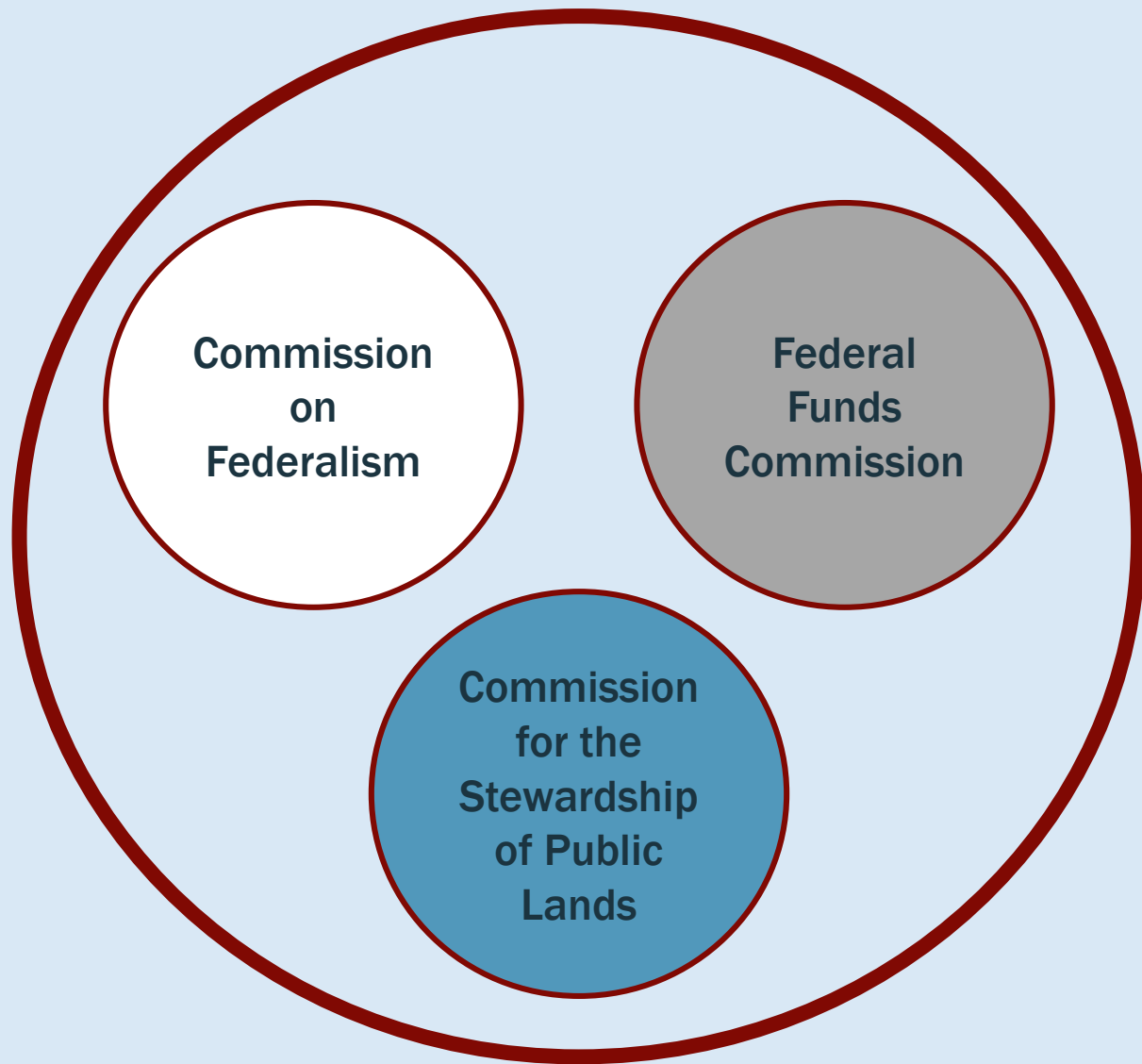

Federalism Commission: Membership

- **9 members**

- President of the Senate, or designee
- Speaker of the House, or designee
- 2 members of Senate
- 3 members of House
- Minority leader of the Senate, or designee
- Minority leader of the House, or designee



Federalism Commission: Meetings, Etc.

- **Quorum**

- Majority

- **Frequency of meetings**

- Up to 9 times/year, unless approved by LMC

- **Contracts**

- May elect to take over contracts from Commission on Federalism, Commission for the Stewardship of Public Lands, or Federal Funds Commission

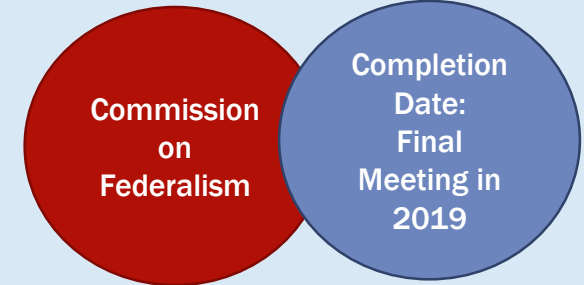

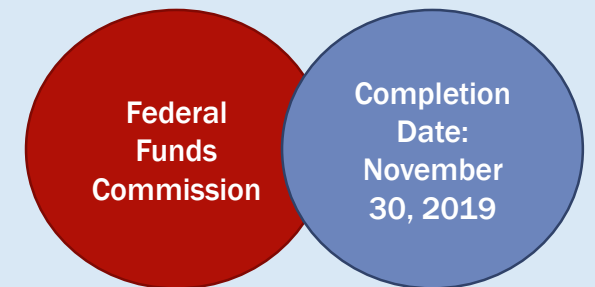


Federalism Commission: Responsibilities

✓ Evaluate “payment in lieu of tax”



✓ Study, assess, and make recommendations on the risk and implications of a reduction in federal funds





Federalism Commission: Reporting Requirements

- **The commission shall submit a report on or before November 30th of each year to:**
 - Government Operations Interim Committee
 - Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee
