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**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

This bill amends and reauthorizes the rural residency training program.

- ▶ adds dental education programs to the list of training programs in the rural residency training program;
- ▶ reauthorizes the rural residency training program for five years; and
- ▶ makes technical changes.

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*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

**53B-24-102. Definitions.**

As used in this chapter:

(1) "Accredited clinical education program" means a clinical education program for a

32 health care profession that is accredited by the Accreditation Council on Graduate Medical  
33 Education.

35 accredited by an entity recognized within medical education circles as an accrediting body for  
36 medical education, advanced practice nursing education, physician assistance education, doctor

50 (a) "Physician" means:

51 (i) a person licensed to practice medicine under Title 58, Chapter 67, Utah Medical  
52 Practice Act or Title 58, Chapter 68, Utah Osteopathic Medical Practice Act; and

53 (ii) a person licensed to practice dentistry under Title 58, Chapter 69, Dentist and  
54 Dental Hygienist Practice Act.

55 (b) "Rural residency training program" means an accredited clinical training program  
56 ~~[as defined in Section 53B-24-102]~~ which places a physician into a rural county for a part or all  
57 of the physician's clinical training.

59 program to place physicians into rural residency training programs.
