FACIAL RECOGNITION PROGRAM



Key Points

- Beginning in 2011, the Statewide Information Analysis Center (SIAC) and Driver License Division (DLD) have utilized Facial Recognition.
- All images collected are associated with an application for a Driver License, Driver Privilege Card, or Identification card, and are retained in one database. Photos are not identified as belonging to a specific type of identification.
- Use of the program is for law enforcement and fraud detection purposes only. No outside agencies have access to the database.
- Law enforcement agencies must provide information indicating investigation is ongoing, such as a case number.
- . Results of the request are for law enforcement purposes only; confirmation of identity is the sole responsibility of the requestor.
- Georgetown University GRAMA request identified;
 - 1,907 law enforcement requests for Facial Recognition assistance (10/2015 11/2017).
 - 816 Federal Requests (231 Department of Homeland Security, 50 ICE specific and 585 additional Federal requests, 430 FBI specific).
- Federal requests have a higher probability of failure due to subject not likely to have applied with the DLD.
- Conviction rates are not reported back to the Department of Public Safety from the investigating agency.
- From 2011 present, DLD has identified 1055 cases of fraud using Facial Recognition Technology.
- SIAC began tracking match successes in December 2015, producing the following results;

SIAC Facial Recognition System Analysis Success Stories

• West Valley City Police Department

Driver License Fraud Case—Photo of female processed and returned 95.3% match. Photo returned revealed female wearing the same coat in both photos.

Bank Robbery—Photos from robbery suspect's phone analyzed and returned match furthering WVCPD's investigation.

• United States—Department of State

Passport Fraud—Subject of Federal investigation query returned two Utah Identifications on passport applications with differing names.

• SBI Alcohol Enforcement Unit

Illegal Club—Investigators submitted photos of person suspected of running an illegal club. Photos returned matches and suspect positively identified.

• Unified Police Department

Sex Assault Investigation—Photo provided following investigation analyzed, and SIAC analyst able to identify male in photo.
