2. Utah Transit Authority Governance Status

2018 General Session S.B. 136 established a new governance structure for the Utah Transit authority, vesting nominations for its board of trustees in executives of local governments and appointment responsibilities in the Governor. The Utah Transit Authority, however, was created in and remains subject to local district statutes (Title 17B). The committee will discuss whether these circumstances suggest the Utah Transit Authority is a state entity.

3. Report: Utah Transit Authority Retirement Benefits
