LAP Data 2016-2019

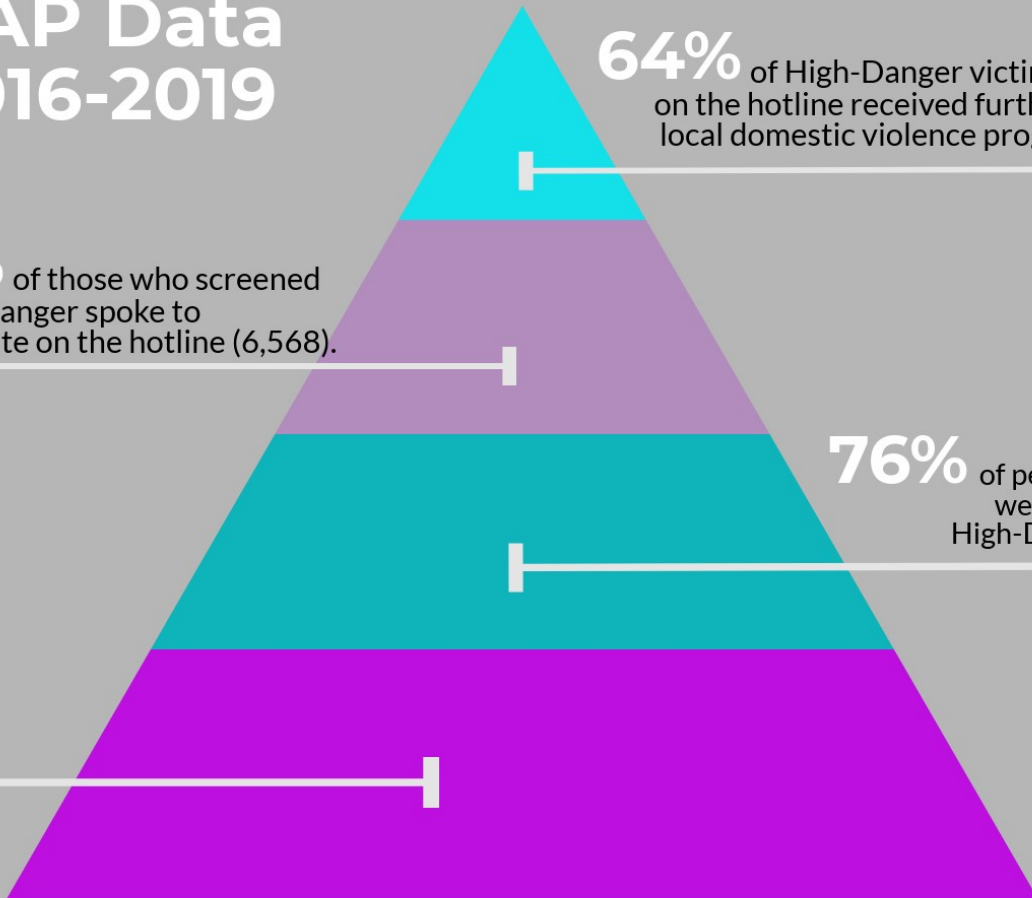
74% of those who screened as High-Danger spoke to an advocate on the hotline (6,568).

64% of High-Danger victims who spoke on the hotline received further services at local domestic violence programs (4,180).

76% of people screened were identified as High-Danger (8,862).

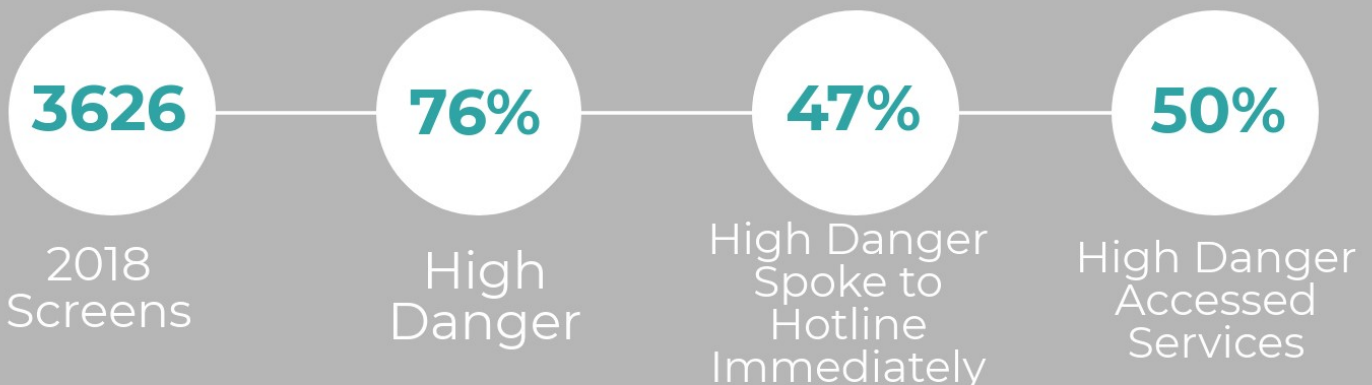
Total # of LAP Screens conducted (by law enforcement, service providers and community agencies).

The UDVC began piloting the LAP in late 2015 with select law enforcement and domestic violence agencies. It has grown to include all 13 community-based DV agencies in Utah and over 60 law enforcement departments - with additional jurisdictions joining every quarter.
