"An individual with a criminal record may apply to the division at any time for a determination of whether the individual's criminal record would disqualify the individual from obtaining a license in an occupation or profession regulated by this title if the individual has completed or were to complete all other licensing requirements for the occupation or profession."

Utah Code § 58-1-310



"Unprofessional conduct" includes "engaging in conduct that results in conviction ... with respect to a crime of moral turpitude or any other crime that, when considered with the functions and duties of the occupation or profession for which the license was issued or is to be issued, bears a [reasonable] substantial relationship to the licensee's or applicant's ability to safely or competently practice the occupation or profession[.]"

Utah Code § 58-1-501(2)
