### Senate Bill 34 (Housing)

#### **NEW PLANNING REQUIREMENTS FOR CITY/COUNTY GENERAL PLANS**

#### Moderate Income Housing Element

- Facilitate an opportunity for variety of housing including moderate income housing
- Analyze how to provide a realistic opportunity for the development of MIH within 5 years
- > Implement 3 or more items from a menu of housing options

#### Land Use Element

Consider where to locate housing for persons with all types of income levels

#### <u>Traffic and Transportation Element</u>

- 1. Consider the region's long range transportation plan developed by MPOs
- 2. Consider active transportation facilities
- 3. Plan for housing and commerce near transit corridors and stations
- Correlate the transportation element with population and employment projections and the proposed land use element

New General Plan Requirements for

Senate Bill 34 (SB34) "Affordable Housing Modifications" encourages local communities to plan for housing for residents of all income levels and to coordinate that housing with transportation and job

To remain eligible for state transportation investments, general plans for affected cities and counties must include revisions to the required Land Use, Transportation and Traffic Circulation, and Moderate Income Housing (MIH) elements by December 1st.




#### **Major Transit Investment Corridors**

Cities and counties that contain the "major transit investment corridors" shown on this map must plan for residential and commercial development around these corridors to improve connections between housing, employment, education, recreation, and commerce (Utah Code 10-9a-403).

"Major transit investment corridor" is defined as public transit service that uses or occupies: (a) public transit rail right-ofway; (b) dedicated road right-of-way for the use of public transit, such as bus rapid transit\*; or (c) fixed-route bus corridors subject to an interlocal agreement or





#### Population **Projections**

SB34 requires municipalities and counties to correlate the transportation plan with population projections and the proposed land use element (SB34 line 502 for municipalities, 1188 for counties). This map shows population projections by 'city area' for 2050. Clicking on a 'city area' provides access to projected population data for each year through 2050.

WFRC works with cities and counties to project (or forecast) future population and employment. These projections are based on county level growth forecasts from the State of Utah. County forecasts are distributed to neighborhoods and commercial districts based on 1) the vision
