3. Rulemaking Update: Driver License Division (Rep. Roberts)

In its June 25 meeting, the committee and representatives of the Driver License Division discussed how first-time learner permit applicants are required to pass a written exam. If learner permit holders choose to take the driver license test 18 months or more from the date the original learner permit was issued, the division requires the applicant to retake the written exam. This requirement is not in agency administrative rule. The committee approved a motion requesting that the division draft an administrative rule making this requirement clear to the public. The division will present its draft rule.
