5 **LONG TITLE**

6 **General Description:**

7 This bill modifies provisions of the Utah Works Program (the program) within the
8 Talent Ready Utah Center.

9 **Highlighted Provisions:**

20 **63N-12-508**, as enacted by Laws of Utah 2019, Chapter 487

22 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

23 Section 1. Section **63N-12-508** is amended to read:

24 **63N-12-508. Utah Works.**

25 (1) There is created within the center the Utah Works Program.

26 (2) The program, under the direction of the center and the talent ready board, shall
27 coordinate and partner with the entities described below to develop [workforce solutions]
28 short-term pre-employment training and short-term early employment training for student and
29 workforce participants that meet the needs of businesses that are creating jobs and economic
30 growth in the state by:

31 (a) partnering with the office, the Department of Workforce Services, the Utah System
32 of Higher Education, and the Utah System of Technical Colleges;

33 (b) [~~identifying~~] partnering with businesses that have significant hiring demands for
34 primarily newly created jobs in the state;

35 (c) coordinating with the Department of Workforce Services to create effective
36 recruitment initiatives to attract student and workforce participants and business participants to
37 the program;

38 (d) coordinating with the Utah System of Higher Education and the Utah System of
39 Technical Colleges to develop educational and training resources to provide student
40 participants in the program qualifications to be hired by business participants in the program;
41 and

42 (e) coordinating with the Board of Education and local education agencies when
43 appropriate to develop educational and training resources to provide student participants in the
44 program qualifications to be hired by business participants in the program.

45 (3) The office, in consultation with the talent ready board, may, in accordance with
46 Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, and in accordance with the
47 provisions of this section, make rules regarding the development and administration of the
48 Utah Works Program.

49 (4) The center shall report the following metrics to the office for inclusion in the
50 office's annual report described in Section 63N-1-301:

51 (a) the number of participants in the program;

52 (b) how program participants learned about or were referred to the program, including
53 the number of participants who learned about or were referred to the program by:

54 (i) the Department of Workforce Services;

55 (ii) marketing efforts of the center or talent ready board;

56 (iii) a school counselor; and

57 (iv) other methods;

58 [~~(b)~~] (c) the number of participants who have completed training offered by the
59 program; and

60 [~~(c)~~] (d) the number of participants who have been hired by a business participating in
61 the program.
