## SUMMARY

Each legislative appropriations subcommittee shall review the federal funds request summary and may recommend that the agency accept the federal funds or participate in the federal program for the fiscal year under consideration or recommend that the agency not accept the federal funds or not participate in the federal program for the fiscal year under consideration."
