2020 GS | Rules, Quorum, & Voting Requirements

Rules & Quorum – NRAEQ Quorum Requirements

- Quorum Requirements (JR3-2-404)
 - 50% in One House & 50% +1 in the Other
 - 6 Senators | 13 Representatives
 - Cannot Split a Person
 - **Majority/Minority Leadership Excluded**
 - Unless Present, then Counted in Quorum
- Voting Requirements
 - 50% of Members in Attendance in One House
 - More than 50% in Attendance in the Other

NRAEQ Funding Overview


