To Whom It May Concern:

We are writing this letter to express our support for a new Health Sciences building at the Bridgerland Technical College. At Logan Regional Hospital, we pride ourselves in hiring the very best and brightest employees available, which is becoming increasingly difficult. There is an extreme shortage of healthcare workers in northern Utah, across the State, and at a National level. With the discussion about Medicaid expansion, any solution to that issue will add to the demand for healthcare workers.

We have a long-standing partnership with Bridgerland and their many healthcare related programs over the years and have several employees that also work part time at Bridgerland as clinical instructors and lecturers. Between Logan Regional Hospital and Intermountain's Medical Group Budge Clinic here on our campus, we estimate we have around 450 employees that have been educated in part or wholly at Bridgerland Technical College in Nursing, Nursing Assistant, Medical Assisting, Pharmacy Technician, Phlebotomy, Medical Office Administration and Medical Coding. We also benefit from their Paramedic program as a community and hospital.






