Supports the SafeUT Crisis Line (\$1.5M one-time allocation)




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## Requirements of the application

- Measurable goals and outcomes
- Three-year implementation plan
  - How qualifying personnel/contracted services will support goals
- Intent of collaboration with local mental health authority
- Description of training
  - Trauma-informed care
  - Advising educators against practicing medicine, giving a diagnosis or providing treatment
- Reporting number of parent seminars and number of attendees





**Common Goals for HB373 Plans** 


- Decrease absenteeism
- Decrease office referrals
- Increase access to mental health resources (information, counseling, skills)
- Increase achievement
- Decrease mental health concerns including self-harm and suicidal ideation



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
