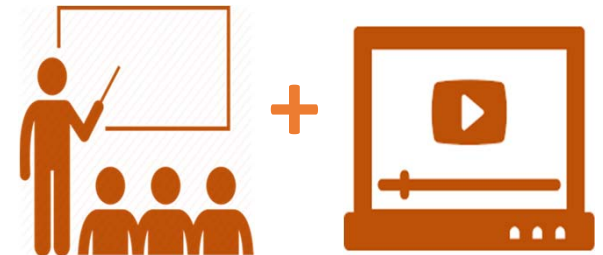

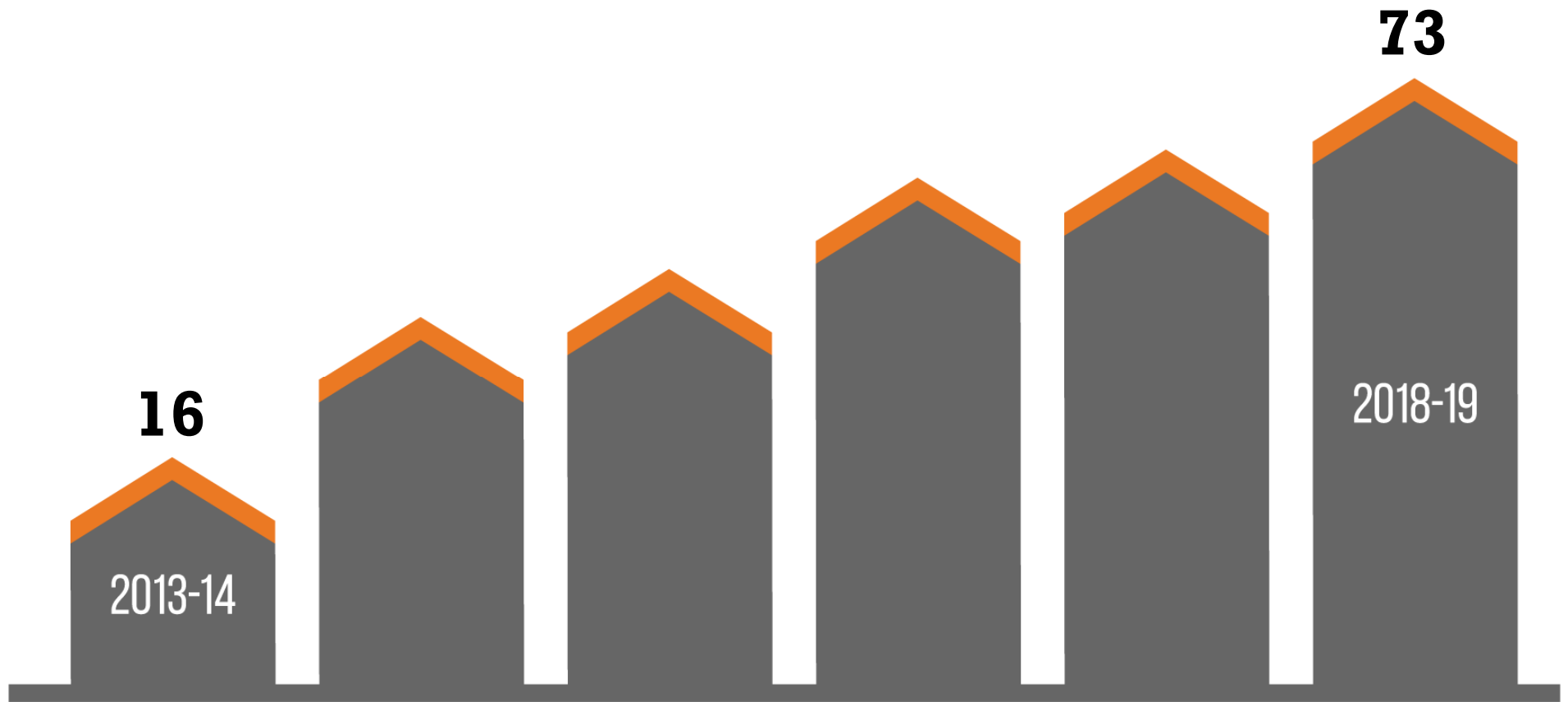

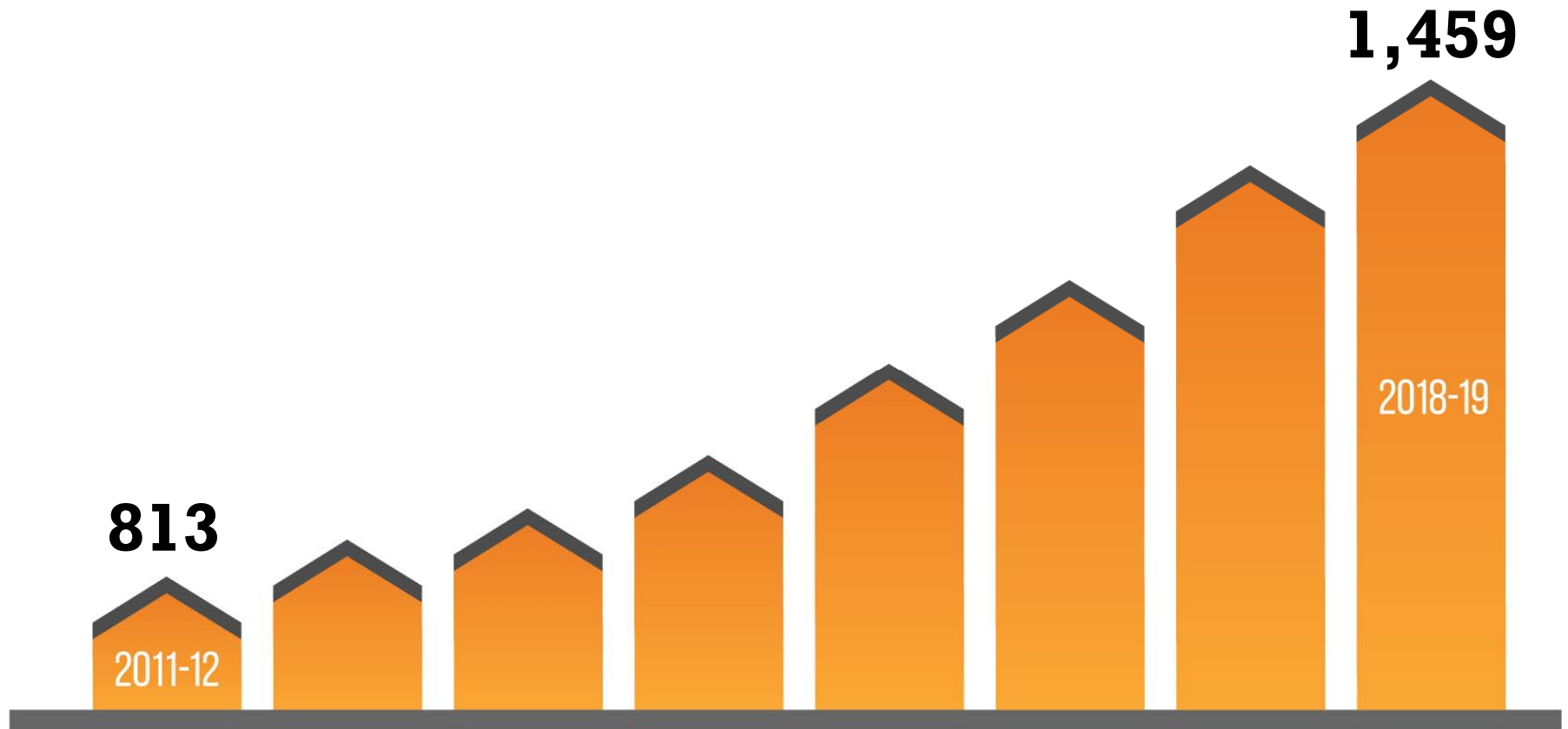
Number of Schools



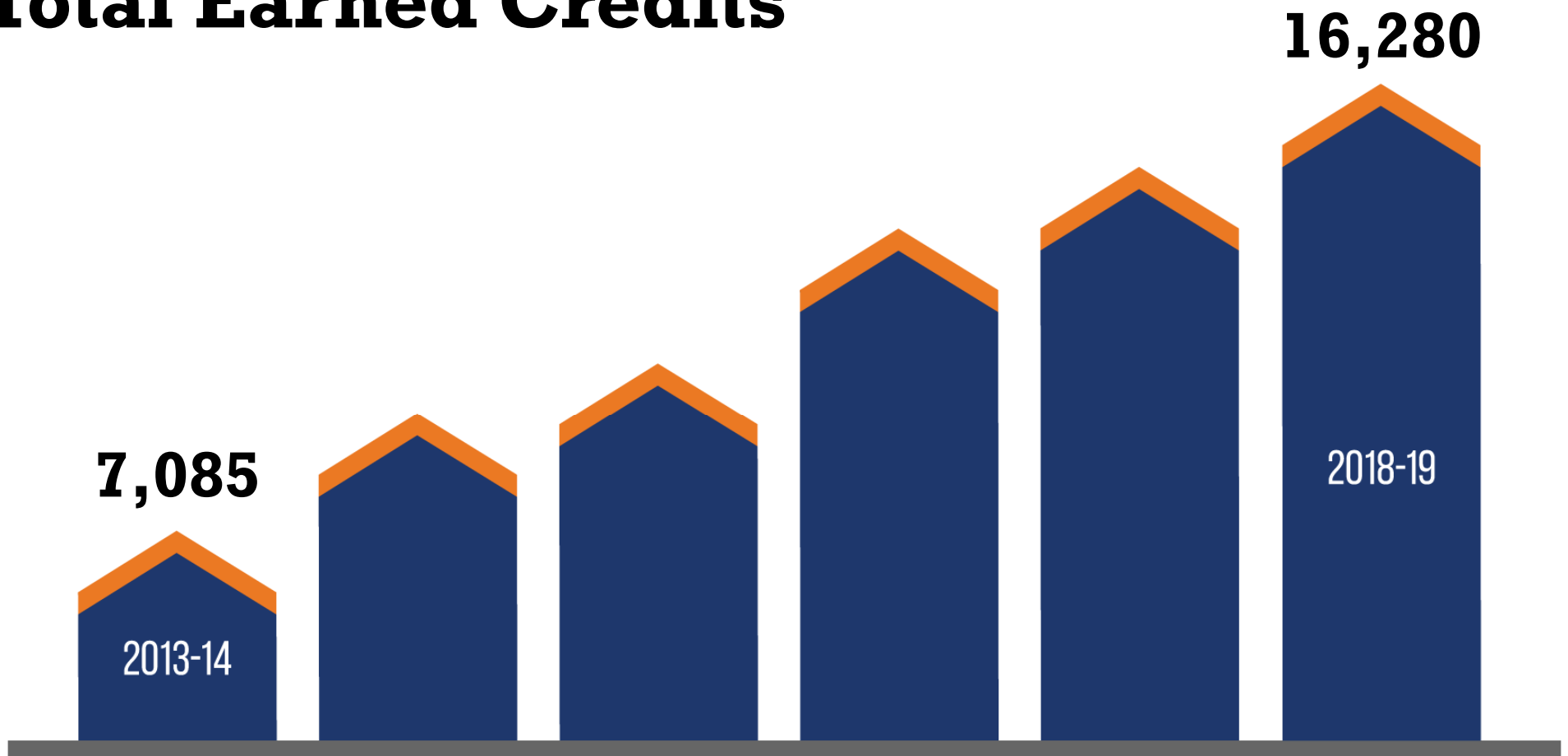
Number of Unique Students



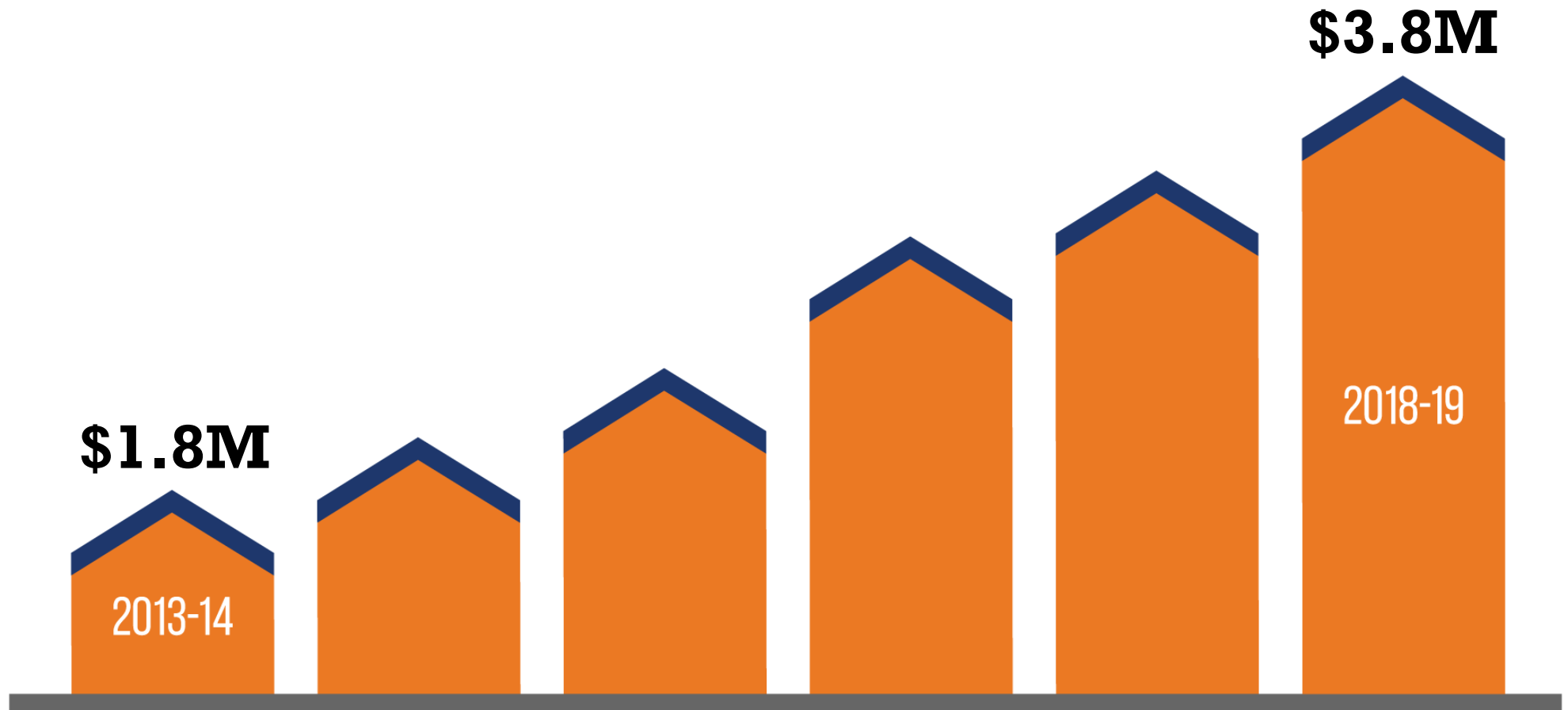
Number of Students at Rural Schools

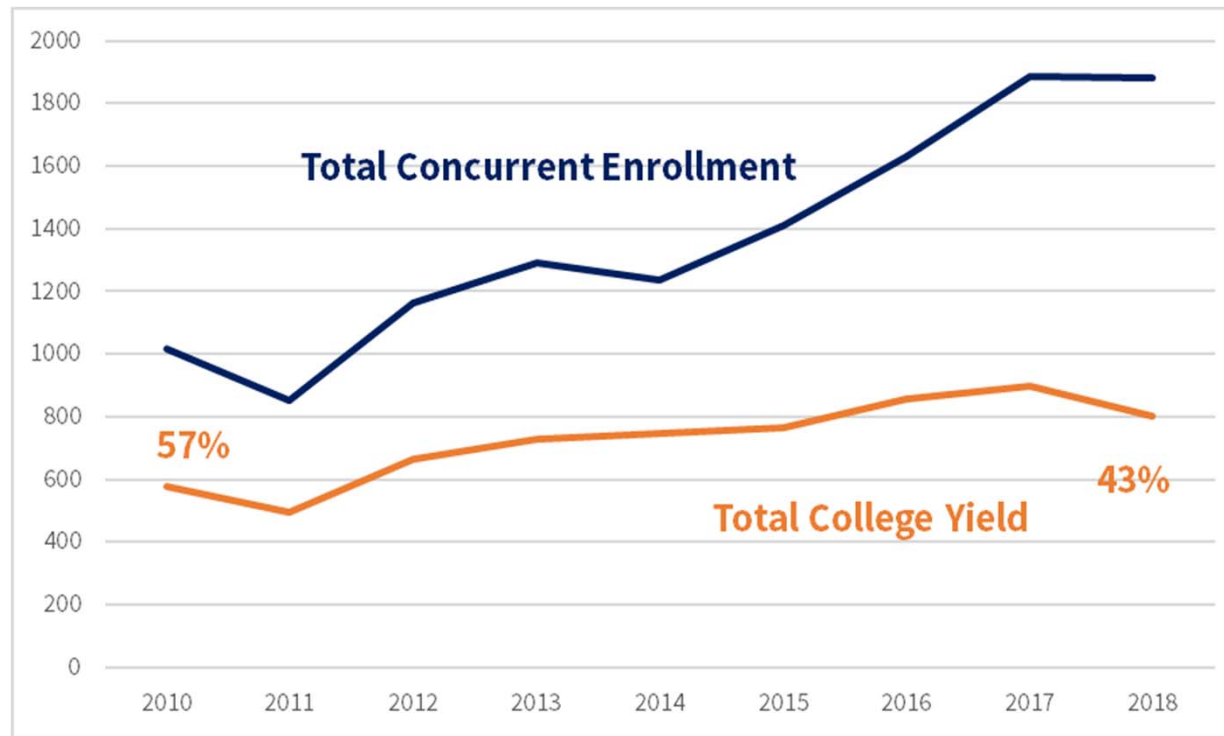

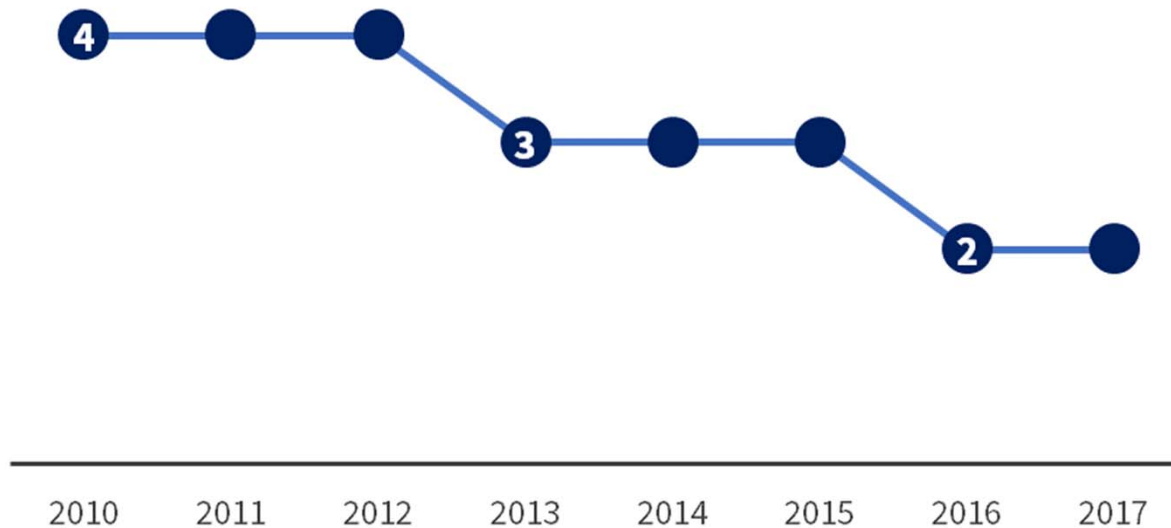
In 2010, 57% of CE students matriculated to Snow College students;

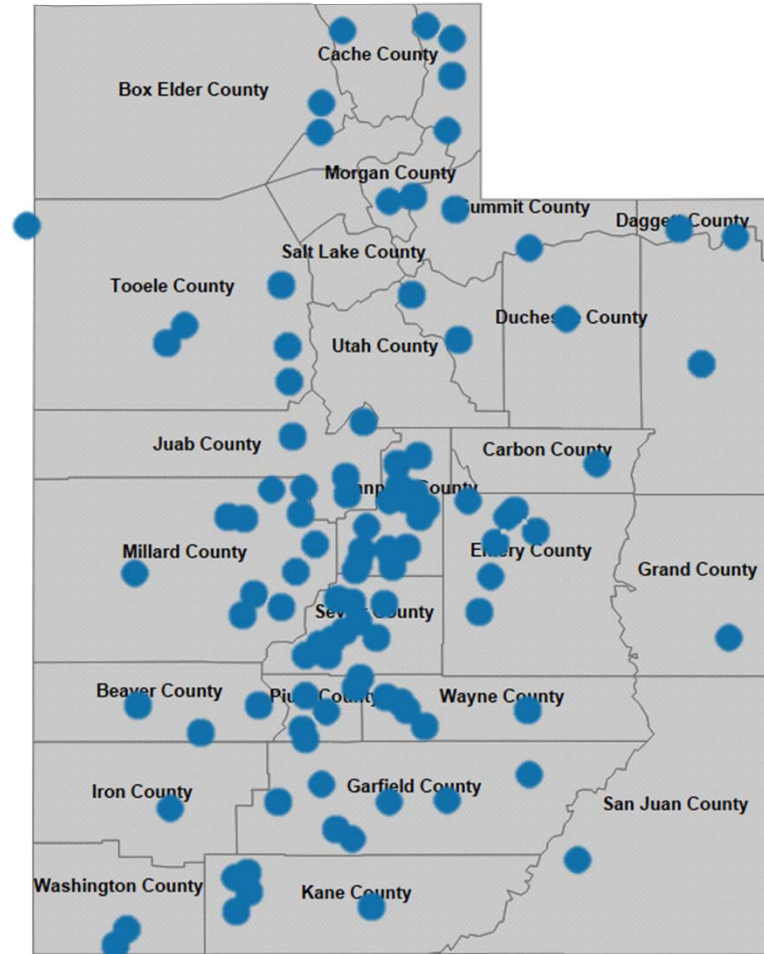
