

**BUDGET:**

The \$1M annual funding will support the following activities related to the project outcomes.

- Support critical ADRD clinical research infrastructure:
  - Develop a program for Cognitive Health Surveillance in Utah. This program will position the ADRC to compete for Centers for Disease Control BOLD Initiative funding that will build a public health infrastructure to address ADRD.
  - Support for a neuroscience advanced imaging program. The ADRC Clinical Core is expected to be able to identify amyloid plaques and neurofibrillary tangles that define Alzheimer's disease in its participants. Support for the advanced neuroimaging (PET scanning) cost will be needed.
- Fund a seed grant program that will stimulate new ADRD collaborations and grow ADRC-related extramurally (NIH) funded projects.
- Support health professions and caregiver education
