ISSUE BRIEF

Appropriations to USHE and UTECH Institutions

The following table summarizes the Legislature appropriations to institutions in the Utah System of Higher Education (USHE) and the Utah System of Technical Colleges from the 2005 General Session through the 2019 General Session for capital development, land bank, and project-specific capital improvements.

The Legislature passed [S.B. 102](#), "Higher Education Capital Facilities," in the 2019 General Session which created the Higher Education Capital Projects Fund (HECPF) and Technical Colleges Capital Projects Fund (TCCPF). The Legislature appropriated \$36.5 million to the HECPF and \$7.0 million to the TCCPF in FY 2021 and directed that \$73.0 million and \$14.0 million be appropriated ongoing beginning in FY 2022 into the respective funds.
