

**2. Sheriff -- Assignment of court bailiffs -- Contract and costs. (17-22-27)**

“The sheriff shall assign law enforcement officers or special function officers... to serve as court bailiffs and security officers in the courts of record and county justice courts.... *The contract may not exceed amounts appropriated by the Legislature for that purpose. The county shall assume costs related to security administration, supervision, travel, equipment, and training of bailiffs.*”

3. **Court Security Account (78A-2-602)** – From a \$50 Court Security fee charged to offenders, the state pays county sheriffs total collections in the Court Security Account (created in 2004). There is no obligated amount the state is to pay and is limited to what is appropriated. “*Subject to appropriation, the Administrative Office of the Courts shall use the allocation to contract for court security at all district and juvenile courts throughout the state.*”
