H.B. 23	Tobacco and Electronic Cigarette Amendments	<i>(Rep. J. Hawkins)</i> <i>(Sen. K. Cullimore)</i>	This bill amends provisions related to tobacco products and electronic cigarettes.
H.B. 73	Interference With Public Servants Amendments	<i>(Rep. C. Maloy)</i> <i>(Sen. J. Anderegg)</i>	This bill clarifies the crimes of interference with public servants and the service of process.
H.B. 171	School Threat Amendments	<i>(Rep. A. Stoddard)</i> <i>(Sen. K. Cullimore)</i>	This bill creates the crime of threats against schools.
H.B. 213	Consent Language Amendments	<i>(Rep. A. Romero)</i> <i>(Sen. T. Weiler)</i>	This bill clarifies when consent may be given or withdrawn for sexual activity.
H.B. 247	Unlawful Sexual Activity Statute of Limitations Amendments	<i>(Rep. S. Handy)</i> <i>(Sen. J. Anderegg)</i>	This bill creates a specific statute of limitations for unlawful sexual activity with a minor.
H.B. 291	Human Trafficking Amendments	<i>(Rep. A. Romero)</i> <i>(Sen. W. Harper)</i>	This bill addresses provisions related to human trafficking.
H.B. 367	Criminal Nonsupport Amendments	<i>(Rep. K. Lisonbee)</i> <i>(Sen. C. Bramble)</i>	This bill makes changes to criminal nonsupport.
H.B. 384	Juvenile Justice Amendments	<i>(Rep. V. Snow)</i> <i>(Sen. T. Weiler)</i>	This bill addresses provisions related to juvenile justice.
H.B. 403	Protective Order and Stalking Injunction Amendments	<i>(Rep. V. Snow)</i> <i>(Sen. T. Weiler)</i>	This bill addresses protective orders and stalking injunctions.
H.B. 433	Mail Theft Amendments	<i>(Rep. W. Brooks)</i> <i>(Sen. D. Ipson)</i>	This bill modifies provisions related to mail theft.
H.B. 441	Criminal Charge Reduction Amendments	<i>(Rep. E. Hutchings)</i> <i>(Sen. T. Weiler)</i>	This bill amends provisions relating to the degree of a criminal offense.
S.B. 32	Prisoner Offense Amendments	<i>(Sen. K. Mayne)</i> <i>(Rep. L. Perry)</i>	This bill modifies provisions related to an offense committed by a prison inmate.
S.B. 37	Electronic Cigarette and Other Nicotine Product Amendments	<i>(Sen. A. Christensen)</i>	This bill enacts and amends provisions relating to electronic cigarette products and nicotine products.

S.B. 102	Bigamy Amendments	(<i>Sen. D. Henderson</i>) (<i>Rep. V. Snow</i>)	This bill modifies provisions defining the crime of and penalties associated with bigamy.
S.B. 173	Disorderly Conduct Amendments	(<i>Sen. D. Ipson</i>) (<i>Rep. L. Perry</i>)	This bill amends criminal provisions relating to disorderly conduct.
S.B. 174	Abortion Prohibition Amendments	(<i>Sen. D. McCay</i>) (<i>Rep. K. Lisonbee</i>)	This bill prohibits a pregnant woman from receiving an abortion, with limited exceptions.
S.B. 197	Consanguinity Amendments	(<i>Sen. K. Mayne</i>) (<i>Rep. P. Ray</i>)	This bill adds definitions of certain relationships to the Utah Criminal Code.
S.B. 214	Gambling Machine and Sweepstakes Amendments	(<i>Sen. K. Mayne</i>) (<i>Rep. T. Hawkes</i>)	This bill modifies provisions relating to gambling.
S.B. 232	Exploitation of a Minor Amendments	(<i>Sen. T. Weiler</i>) (<i>Rep. S. Waldrip</i>)	This bill addresses the offenses of sexual exploitation of a minor.
S.B. 237	Aggravated Kidnapping Amendments	(<i>Sen. T. Weiler</i>) (<i>Rep. V. Snow</i>)	This bill modifies a provision related to aggravated kidnapping.
S.B. 238	Battered Person Mitigation Amendments	(<i>Sen. D. Thatcher</i>) (<i>Rep. V. Snow</i>)	This bill provides for mitigation of certain criminal charges related to cohabitant abuse.
